

Green Houses & Gardens



Gardens can be used to beautify a property with flowers and greenery. They can also be used to grow fruits, vegetables, spices and herbs. Olive Plant was a notorious gardener when she lived at Lucknow. She had a 100 foot, curved, glass greenhouse that spanned the lakeside of the property. The greenhouse was used to extend the growth period of plants and create a micro-environment for more tropical plants so that they could grow in the harsh New Hampshire climate.

Plant Your Own Garden

MATERIALS:

- OLD EGG CARTON
- Soil
- SMALL SHOVEL
- SEEDS (YOU CAN BUY THESE AT ANY HARDWARE STORE, MOST GROCERY STORES, OR AT YOUR NEXT VISIT TO CASTLE IN THE CLOUDS)
- WATER

INSTRUCTIONS:

Fill the egg carton with soil, drop a few seeds in each section of the carton and push down with your finger, about to your first knuckle. Cover up the hole with new dirt. Sprinkle some water over the seeds daily, and place the carton somewhere where it'll get plenty of sunlight.
