Make Your Own Landscape

MATERIALS:

- Paper
- Pencil
- Glue
- Markers
- Crayons
- Scissors
- Anything else you have – tissue paper, scrap book papers, pompoms, straws, pipe cleaners, wrapping paper, etc.

HOW TO:

Landscapes have 3 parts – a **Background** (way in the back), a **Middle Ground** (in the middle) and a **Foreground** (what's at the very front of the picture).

Start with the background and add pieces to make up the middle ground and the foreground. Think about what kind of day you want to show in your picture – is it sunny with blue skies, is it cloudy, is it rainy? What season is it? Does it show countryside or does it show a city?

Pro tip – arrange all of your pieces and take a picture, then glue them all down to make sure the picture is exactly what you want it to be!
