- By achieving the goals set forth in this plan we will improve our visitor experience, and develop plans to better welcome visitors to Castle in the Clouds.

Facilities

- Adopt and implement a Facilities Master Plan for the organization
- Continue historic restoration and preservation
- Plan for and conduct repairs and improvements to facilities infrastructure
- Plan for and implement new facilities investments that support the mission and vision



Education

- Adopt and implement an organizational Interpretive Plan
- Establish advisory groups to assist with school and public program development
- Create diverse outreach opportunities for school-age children
- Expand public programming to meet community needs and interest and regularly measure and evaluate program performance
- Seek support from grant makers and government programs in support of educational goals



Arts & Partnerships

- Integrate the arts across the Castle property
- Expand and strengthen current key partnerships with LRCT and Great Waters
