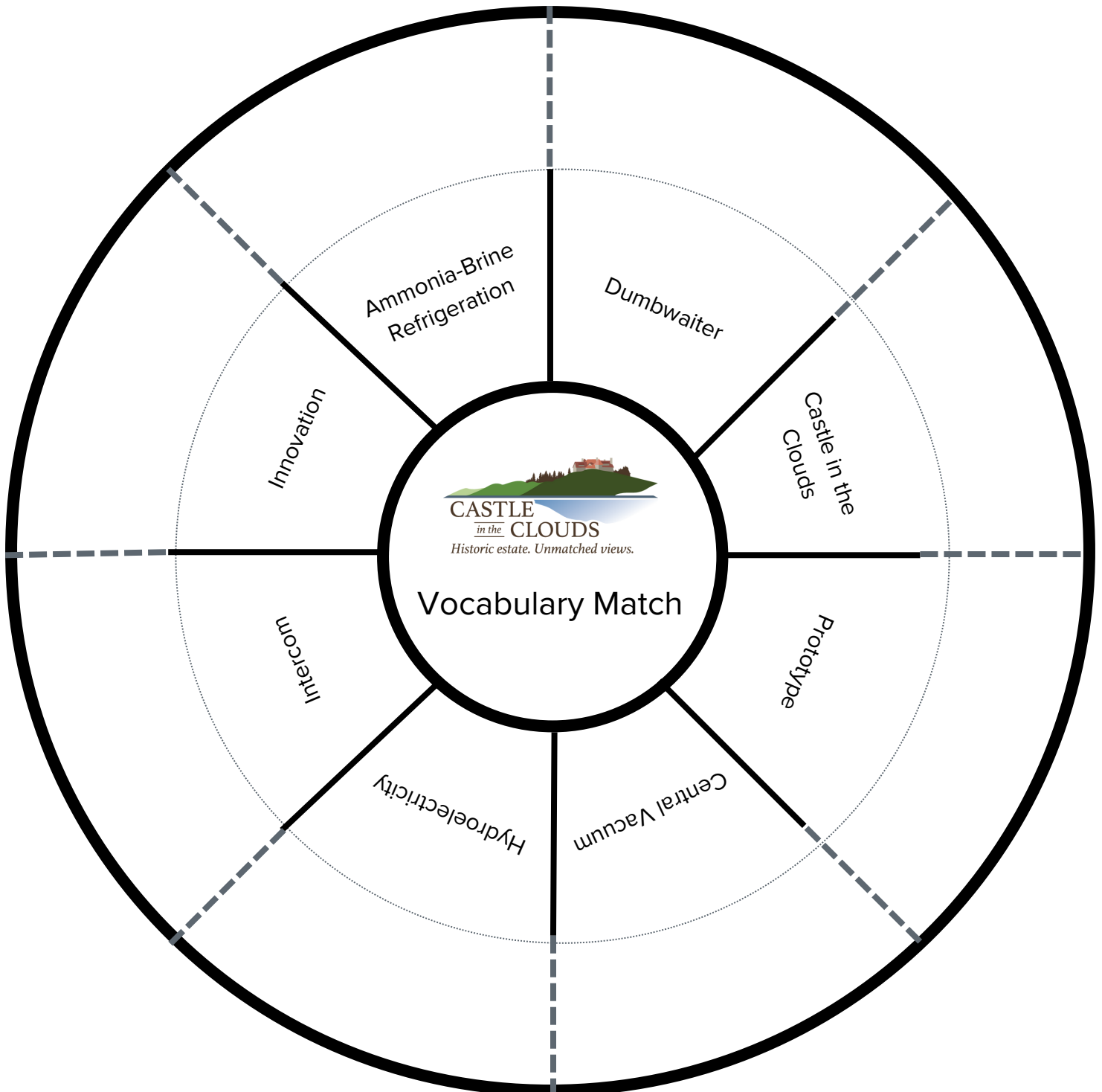


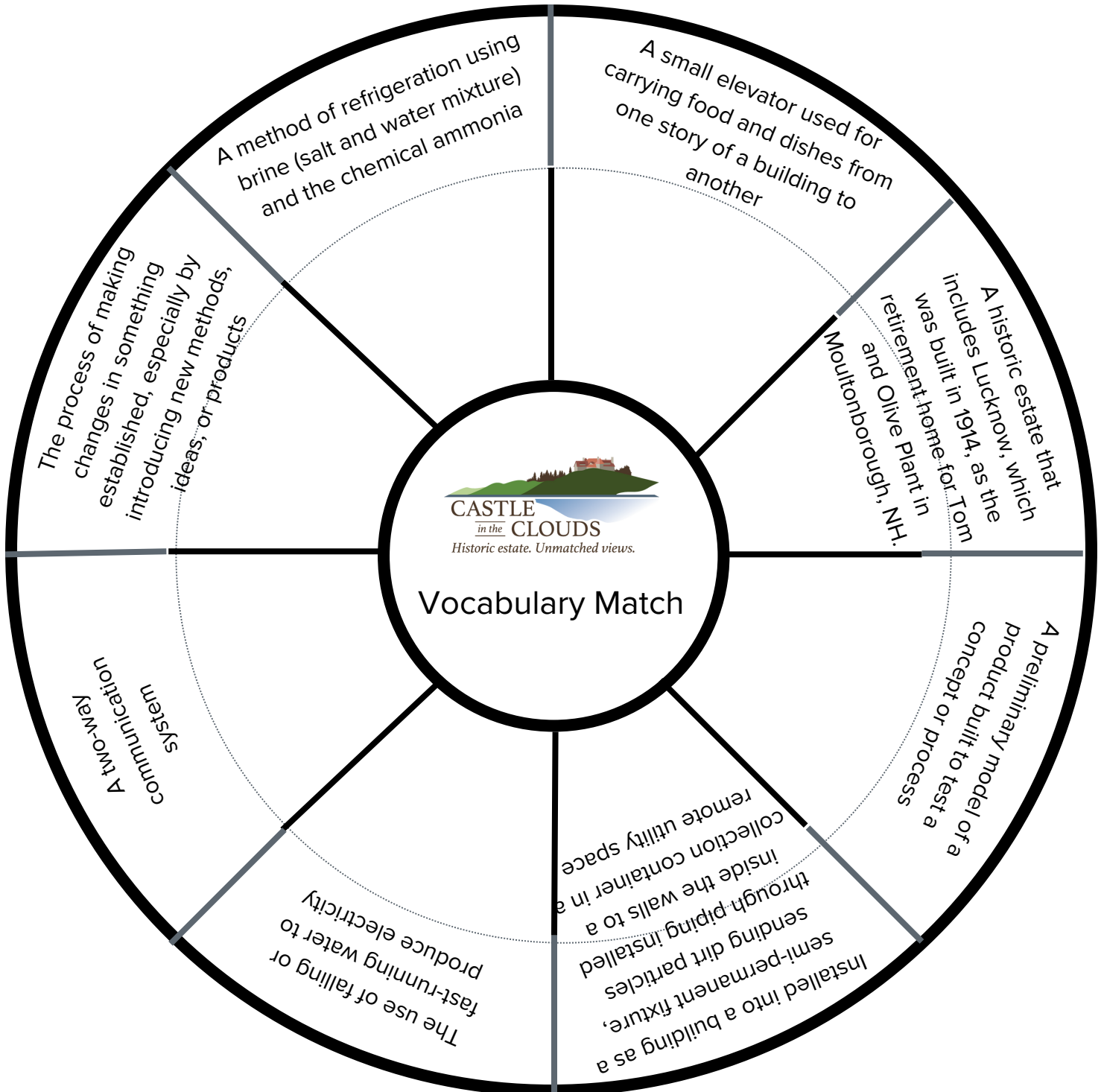
Directions:

Cut out the biggest circle on both pages and then cut along the dotted lines from the outside of the circle to where the line becomes solid on the vocabulary word circle only. Put both circles together so that the circle with the vocabulary words facing up is on top of the circle with the definitions (also facing up). Poke a hold in the middle of the circle and affix a fastener to keep the two circles together. Make sure the fastener is a little loose so that the circles can be moved around in order to match the vocabulary word to the definition. To check to see if you are correct, fold back the vocabulary word to see if it matches the definition underneath.

Directions:

On the other circle, write the definition on the top part of the circle, so when underneath the vocabulary word, the definition can be seen when folding back the flap above it on the vocabulary word circle. Put both circles together so that the circle with the vocabulary words facing up is on top of the circle with the definitions (also facing up). Poke a hold in the middle of the circle and affix a fastener to keep the two circles together. Make sure the fastener is a little loose so that the circles can be moved around in order to match the vocabulary word to the definition.
